Schisandra chinensis Fruit Powder

DEFINITION

The article consists of dried ripe fruits of *Schisandra chinensis* (Turcz.) Baill. (Family Schisandraceae) collected in the fall, reduced to a powder. It contains NLT 0.40% of schisandrin (schisandrol A, $C_{24}H_{32}O_7$) on the dried basis; and NLT 0.95% of total lignans calculated as the sum of schisandrin, schisandrol B ($C_{23}H_{28}O_7$), schisandrin A (deoxyschisandrin, $C_{24}H_{32}O_6$), and schisandrin B (γ -schisandrin, $C_{23}H_{28}O_6$), on the dried basis.
