## Citrus reticulata Peel Powder

#### *Citrus reticulata* Peel Powder

---

#### DEFINITION

The article consists of the dried ripe pericarp of *Citrus reticulata* Blanco (Family Rutaceae) collected in autumn or winter, reduced to a fine or very fine powder. It contains NLT 5.0% of total dihydroflavone glycosides, calculated as the sum of narirutin (C<sub>27</sub>H<sub>32</sub>O<sub>14</sub>), hesperidin (C<sub>28</sub>H<sub>34</sub>O<sub>15</sub>), and didymin (C<sub>28</sub>H<sub>34</sub>O<sub>14</sub>), on the anhydrous basis; and NLT 0.1% of total polymethoxylated flavones, calculated as the sum of nobiletin (C<sub>21</sub>H<sub>22</sub>O<sub>8</sub>), 3,5,6,7,8,3',4'-heptamethoxyflavone (C<sub>22</sub>H<sub>24</sub>O<sub>9</sub>), and tangeretin (C<sub>20</sub>H<sub>20</sub>O<sub>7</sub>), on the anhydrous basis.
