Polygonum multiflorum Root

DEFINITION

The article consists of the dried root of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb. with the currently accepted Latin name *Reynoutria multiflora* (Thunb.) Moldenke (Family Polygonaceae)¹, collected in autumn or winter. It contains NLT 1.5% of 2,3,5,4'-tetrahydroxystilbene-2-O-β-D-glucoside (C₂₀H₂₂O₉) on the dried basis; NLT 0.10% of total anthraquinones, calculated as the sum of emodin-8-O-β-D-glucoside (C₂₁H₂₀O₁₀), physcion-8-O-β-D-glucoside (C₂₂H₂₂O₁₀), emodin (C₁₅H₁₀O₅), and...
