DEFINITION

The article consists of the dried root of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb., with the currently accepted Latin

name *Reynoutria multiflora* (Thunb.) Moldenke (Fam. Polygonaceae)¹, collected in autumn or winter. It contains NLT 1.5% of 2,3,5,4'-tetrahydroxystilbene-2-*O*- β -D-Glucoside (C₂₀H₂₂O₉) on the dried basis; NLT 0.10% of total anthraquinones, calculated as the sum of emodin-8-*O*- β -D-glucoside (C₂₁H₂₀O₁₀), physcion-8-*O*- β -D-glucoside (C₂₂H₂₂O₁₀), emodin (C_{15...}
