Polygonum multiflorum Root Dry Extract

DEFINITION

The article is prepared from the dried root of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb., with the currently accepted Latin name *Reynoutria multiflora* (Thunb.) Moldenke (Fam. Polygonaceae) 1 , collected in autumn or winter and extracted with a mixture of alcohol and water (7:3). The ratio of starting crude plant material to Dry Extract is between 3:1 and 5:1. It contains NLT 90.0% and NMT 110.0% of the labeled amount of 2,3,5,4'-tetrahydroxystilbene-2-O- β -D-glucoside ($C_{20}H_{22}O_9$) on the dried basis; NLT 90.0% and NMT 110.0% of the labeled amount of total anthraquinones, calculated as the sum of emodin-8-O- β -...

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
