Polygonum multiflorum Root Powder

DEFINITION

The article consists of the dried root of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb. with the currently accepted Latin name *Reynoutria multiflora* (Thunb.) Moldenke (Family Polygonaceae)¹, collected in autumn or winter, reduced to a fine or very fine powder. It contains NLT 1.5% of 2,3,5,4'-tetrahydroxystilbene-2-O- β -D-glucoside (C₂₀H₂₂O₉), on the dried basis; NLT 0.10% of total anthraquinones, calculated as the sum of emodin-8-O- β -D-glucoside (C₂₁H₂₀O₁₀), physcion-8-O- β -D-glucoside (C₂₂H...
