Polygonum multiflorum Root Powder

## **DEFINITION**

The article consists of the dried root of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb. with the currently accepted Latin name *Reynoutria multiflora* (Thunb.) Moldenke (Family Polygonaceae)<sup>1</sup>, collected in autumn or winter, reduced to a fine or very fine powder. It contains NLT 1.5% of 2,3,5,4'-tetrahydroxystilbene-2-O- $\beta$ -D-glucoside ( $C_{20}H_{22}O_9$ ), on the dried basis; NLT 0.10% of total anthraquinones, calculated as the sum of emodin-8-O- $\beta$ -D-glucoside ( $C_{21}H_{20}O_{10}$ ), physcion-8-O- $\beta$ -D-glucoside ( $C_{22}H_{33}O_{34}$ ).
