Salvia miltiorrhiza Root and Rhizome Dry Extract

DEFINITION

The article is prepared from the dried roots and rhizomes of *Salvia miltiorrhiza* Bunge (Family Lamiaceae), collected in spring or fall, by extraction with hydroalcoholic mixtures. The ratio of starting crude plant material to Dry Extract is 10:1. It contains NLT 90.0% and NMT 110.0% of the labeled amount of tanshinones, calculated as the sum of cryptotanshinone, tanshinone I, and tanshinone II_A; and NLT 90.0% and NMT 110.0% of the labeled amount of salvianolic acid B; all calculated on the dried basis.
